TRANSPORT & PARKING

Southern Railway tend to ban bikes or only permit a very limited number of prebooked bikes on the day, so we strongly advise you arrange to be picked up from Brighton or book our bike and coach transport (subject to availability).

Our return coaches will be leaving Brighton regularly from 12:30 onwards.

These will operate on a first come, first served basis.

Bikes will be transported to Clapham Common in secure bike vans and will meet you there upon your arrival.

There is only a limited amount of spaces and once they're gone, they're gone! We expect these to sell out! Please book via the link below. RIDER PACKS



Rider packs will begin to be posted shortly so please keep a look out in the post for yours.

The pack you receive will contain two numbers that look similar to the image above. One paper number with safety pins, which you attach to the back of your jersey\jacket. The second number is hardback and has holes punched through it, please use the two cable ties to attach this to the handlebars of your bike. Please ensure the number isn't obscured in anyway as this will be the number the photographers use to log the photos taken of you on the day!

On the morning of the ride please arrive with both numbers attached, this will save any delays and you'll be ready to head to the start line for your time slot no need to register or join any queues!

We are aiming for all rider packs to be posted and have arrived by Wednesday 4th September. Please only email if your pack hasn't arrived by this date.

WHAT TO BRING ON THE DAY

Please bring any clothing you want to wear on the day and dress appropriately for the weather.

Helmets are compulsory on this ride – it is not permitted to cycle on our event without a cycling helmet.

Water bottles should be filled at home with your drink of choice and can be refilled with water at the stops. There are also several 24hr petrol stations along the route plus shops opening mid morning should you need to buy extra refreshments during the ride.

A bike lock will keep your bike secure if you want to leave it at any point. Skyline do not accept liability for lost or stolen bikes left by participants.

BIKE SUITABILITY

The route is entirely on road so please ensure your bike is suitable for this. Whilst using a mountain bike is possible, they are much heavier and it will be more challenging!

We recommend using a lightweight road bike, or hybrid bike. We strongly recommend fitting bike lights for additional safety on shaded lanes, mist or fog on route and overcast weather regardless of start time.

It is also advisable to have your bike serviced before the ride to ensure it's in good condition - Our friends at BikeBook can help you find a local mechanic, please check their website here

It must have independent brakes on both wheels, fixed wheel bikes are not allowed.

If you are considering riding a non-standard type of bike, please check the event
