Set Up Your Online Fundraising Page

Create a <u>JustGiving</u> page and share it everywhere Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn, WhatsApp, the more people who see it, the more likely they are to support you. Personalise your story, add training updates, and don't forget to thank your donors!

m Check for Matched Giving

Many companies offer matched giving doubling the donations you receive. Ask your employer if they support this. It's an easy way to increase your total without asking twice.

Tin Shaking with a Twist

Get creative! Set up a static bike challenge at a supermarket, gym, or train station and collect donations as you ride. Just make sure to check if you need permission or a council permit.

Always Have your Fundraising Page to Hand

You never know who you'll bump into! People are often happy to give when they hear what you're doing.

Mark Host a Fundraising Event

Think: BBQ, brunch, quiz night, karaoke, dinner party. Charge a small entry fee, add a raffle, and make it a night to remember!

Get Schools Involved

Ask local schools to run a non-uniform day, or organise a mini sponsored event with students, it's fun for them and great publicity for your cause.

Offer Odd Jobs

From weeding gardens to ironing shirts, offer your time and skills in exchange for donations. People love helping when they get something useful in return!

Solution Celebrate with a Cause

Got a birthday coming up? Ask for donations instead of gifts and let your celebration support something bigger.

Spread the Word

Tell everyone, and we mean everyone, what you're doing and why. Add it to your email signature, post updates, send messages.

Your passion will inspire support.
